## Annual APY Lands Permit Due

The end of the financial year is fast approaching. APY would like to remind everyone to complete your Permit application for the New Financial Year 1/7/19 to 30/6/20.

APY Permits are only valid for one Financial Year at a time.

To assist the Permits officer to complete all Providers Permits can you please review all your staff and send in a new Permit application by 01<sup>st</sup> June, 2019, if there are staff that you are not aware of at the time please send through as soon as practicable thereafter, or throughout the year ahead.

APY holds the responsibility under the Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Land Rights Act Sec 6 Pt 1 (a), (b) & (c), to protect the Interests of Anangu on the APY Lands, by assessing anyone that wishes to use, occupy or enter the Lands, granting them permission or otherwise refusing permission, to enter the APY Lands.

All Contractors, Employees and Visitors to the APY Lands must fill in a Permit application appropriate to their needs, Media, Research or General and provide as much detail as possible for APY to complete an assessment of the application.

All applicants must send in a Criminal History Police check at your cost.

If anyone enters the Lands without a Permit, a \$2,000 Fine applies, with \$500 Fine per day thereafter if on the lands.

APY have taken the liberty of attaching the Permit applications to this email for your convenience.
